

## Instruction to the Applicants of B.A. (Gen) Course

1. Choose a Combination of three subjects among the six subject combinations available in our college:
  - 1) Bengali-History-Education
  - 2) Bengali-Education-English
  - 3) Bengali-Film Studies-English
  - 4) Political Science-Economics-History
  - 5) Political Science-Education-History
  - 6) Political Science-Film Studies-History
2. Among the three subjects in your subject combination choose any two subjects as **General Subject 1** and **General Subject 2**
  - For these two subjects you have to study 4 courses from each of them. These two subjects will be core courses in your B.A. General course.
3. The subject other than **General Subject 1** and **General Subject 2** in your Subject Combination will be **Generic Elective**.
  - For the **Generic Elective**, you have to study only 2 courses.
  - You **can't choose English as your Generic Elective subject**.
  - You **can't choose Bengali as your Generic Elective if you want to study it as your language subject(LCC2)**
4. You have to study two Language subjects (LCC1 and LCC2) in B.A. General Course.
  - LCC1 is Compulsory English.
  - LCC2 can be Bengali or Alternative English
  - You have to study Alternative English as LCC2 if you have chosen Bengali as Generic Elective.
5. For the subject combination **Bengali-History-Education**, you have to choose Bengali as one of your **General Subject (1 or 2)**, if you want to choose **Bengali as LCC2**.
6. For the subject combinations **Bengali-Education-English or Bengali-Film Studies-English**, you have to choose English as one of your **General Subject (1 or 2)**. The other **General Subject (1 or 2)** must be **Bengali**, if you want to choose **Bengali as LCC2**.
